RULES AND REGULATIONS OF ENTRY



1. Individual Amateur Competitors must pay a nonrefundable \$20.00 event entrance fee that will provide admission to the Games site and admission to a fiddling workshop.

Individual competitors must include a stamped self-addressed envelope with the payment and entry form submission.

2. **ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN April 15th , 2015.**
 3. No person may compete unless Highland Dress and a competitor number are worn. An exception is made for Novice Classes. Modified concert dress is acceptable. (Tasteful black slacks, or skirt and white top) Competitor numbers are obtained at the Competition Registration table in the Clan area.
 4. Order of Competition within Class will be determined by receipt of entry. First received will perform last, and vice versa. If a competitor is not present when his/her number is called, he/she will be subject to disqualification in that particular event. The Scottish Games Association of Delaware (SGAD) reserves the right to limit the number of entries in any event. In such case, after the maximum number of entries for an event is received, subsequent entries will be returned along with the entry fee.
 5. All classes of the Fiddling Competitions are sanctioned by the Scottish Fiddling Revival Ltd. Organization (SFIRE) and will conform to SFIRE's requirements and rules for sanctioned events. It is required for competitors in the Open and Junior Classes to currently have membership in SFIRE. (See Fair Hill Scottish Games or the SFIRE website for membership form)
 6. SGAD reserves the right to cancel any event due to lack of competitors or participants.
 7. In any contest with three or less competitors, there will be one less prize awarded than the number of competitors.
 8. All prize money will be mailed to competitors within one week of the day of the Gathering.
 9. Decisions by the Steward and Judge(s) will be final.
 10. Any complaints must be forwarded to the Office of the Gathering within 10 days after the Gathering along with a \$15.00 processing charge.
 11. ***It has yet to be determined if Field entries will be taken at registration on day of competition.***
